

Peru Selectboard Meeting
April 1, 2020

Present: Jon Mowry, Chuck Black. Todd Williams, Wayne Blanchard, Brian Bills and Jennie Freeman (via phone)

Meeting Called to Order: Jon called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM

Review and Approve Minutes: Todd made a motion to approve minutes March 18, 2020 meeting. Jon seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

Review and Approve 2020 Town Meeting Minutes. Jon made a motion to approve the 2020 Town Meeting minutes. Chuck seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.

No request to change the agenda.

No public comment.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Town Road Crew Summer Hours - Wayne and Brian would like to work the hours of 6:00 AM - 2:30 PM in summer. Chuck made a motion to amend the Personnel Policy to keep the road crew hours at 6:00 AM – 2:30 PM year round. Jon seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.
2. Request submitted by Zoning Administrator – A request was made from the Planning Commission to file building permits, septic permits, and other notifications to a property by Parcel ID rather than by homeowners' names to simplify research on a property when homeowner changes. The request is for \$500 to fund the purchase of two filing cabinets and file folders necessary for this re-organization of documents. Town Clerk to discuss with Zoning Administrator and to be further discussed at next Selectboard meeting.
3. Emergency Health Order and related expenses – Discussion around ongoing complaints by neighbors of coyotes and fisher cats getting into garbage of Peru residents home due to improper disposal of trash and human waste. Legal measures have been taken, but due to inability of another entity to step in, Peru Fire Department and other volunteers conducted a clean up of the property and purchased supplies to help manage the waste disposal. Jon Mowry will plan on picking up garbage and taking to transfer station for the time being. Both immediate interference to address public health as well as legal paths are being pursued.

OLD BUSINESS

Road Foreman Report – Spring clean up. Currently sweeping dirt off of black top. Due to amount of dirt a new brush is needed. The cost for this replacement is

\$751.00 for brush and freight. Jon recommended Wayne proceed with this purchase.

OTHER BUSINESS

Suburban Heating Partners, Miller Construction and GW Construction submitted Overweight Permits for approval. Jon made a motion to approve all permits, with the contingency that loads originate and terminate in Peru and confirmation of proper insurance for GW Construction is on file. Chuck seconded. All in favor. Motion passed.
