Meeting Called to Order: Todd called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm

Review and Approve Minutes: Motion to approve minutes as printed by Chuck. Seconded by Todd. All in favor.

Discussion regarding where to source salt for the winter. Todd made a motion that we purchase our road salt from American Rock Salt at \$65.83/ton delivered. Chuck seconded. All in favor.

Fence – Homeowner on South Rd. put up a fence up that could be damaged in winter with the addition of snow. Todd contacting homeowner to suggesting removing or pushing fence back in winter to prevent damage.

Carl Ekdahl – Todd called today to let him know ditch work will happen on Little Michgan next week.

Chuck asked about big culvert on Little Michigan Rd. Daniels got extension on permit so it can indeed be done this fall.

Speed bumps to be pulled up in October in preparation for winter plowing.
